



2025 Baja Nevada: The Long Way Race Information

Thank you for joining us for the 2025 Legacy Racing Series. Below are some general rules & guidelines to follow. Please refer to our Rulebook for information on classes as well as safety regulations and more details on competition regulations.

Registration

1. Please make sure someone from your team goes through Registration PRIOR to your vehicle going through Tech.
2. All drivers/riders and co-drivers/riders must come through registration.
3. Minors will need to have a parent or guardian present to sign insurance waivers, including a notarized form. We have a notary on staff but if you want to get it done beforehand to speed things up email us at info@legacyracing.net for a form.
4. Event T-shirts and membership hats will be located in the Registration room, make sure you pick them up when you register.
5. Late registration will be Friday Morning at the start line for Motorcycles & Quads, at Staging for Cars, Trucks & UTVs

Contingency & Tech Inspection

1. All Vehicles must go through Tech inspection!
2. Stop by the Contingency Table to fill out your forms and pick up any necessary decals.
3. You must off-load your vehicles in the designated parking lot (see Diagram). **DO NOT PARK YOUR TRAILERS IN THE PAHRUMP NUGGET PARKING LOT**
4. Stop by the RacingTrax table to pick up your Tracker. It is mandatory for **ALL** classes. If you have not registered for your RacingTrax Unit please do so today!

Meetings

1. Racer meeting is – 1 PM - motorcycle, quad, 3 Wheeler; 2:30pm; car, truck, UTV in the Pahrump Nugget Event Center
2. It is Mandatory to attend the meeting. There must be at least one arm banded member of your team is present. We will call a random 15 names for each meeting. Meeting will NOT be online.
3. Media Meeting 3:30 pm -this is a mandatory meeting for all media personal including helicopter pilots

Communications

1. We will be using radio frequency 152.960
2. Please only use this frequency to listen to updates and report any emergencies. This is not for racer updates.
3. If you need assistance on finding your race vehicle or to report them being broke down, see the Pit Captain at any of the 25 pits or the Legacy Box Van at the Finish Line.
4. Helicopters must register with us prior to the event. Please email info@legacyracing.net for Helicopter Registration form.

Start

1. Please be on time to staging! Motorcycles & Quads is 3 am. Car, Truck, UTV begins at 8:30am. Please see schedule of events for your specific time.
2. You are NOT allowed to top off your race vehicle with fuel at the start line.

Camping

1. Camping in Pahrump is allowed behind the Smith's, Camping is allowed in Tonopah at the OHV staging area next to the Rodeo Grounds (same location as Gold Rush Finish)

Race Course Information

1. Please stay on the marked course. Short cutting is not allowed and will result in a penalty.
2. Your Pit crew is not allowed to assist you on the race course. Please radio for a Legacy official and they will send someone out to assist you, whether it be a tow, fuel or parts.
3. Paved road crossings are a mandatory stop, 25mph speed zone for all race vehicles. All Race vehicles have fifteen (15) paved road crossings with Three (3) Underpass. All Vehicles will have Four (4) county paved road crossings that are not a mandatory stop.
4. If you get a flat tire, do NOT leave it in the desert! You will be penalized one hour if we find a flat that was intentionally left. Please make sure to mark all Tires, jacks, extinguishers etc., this will assist us in returning them to their proper homes if lost on course.
5. Course markings – Yellow is direction, Green is Turn Ahead, White – Wrong Way, Pink – hair pin, White – mile markers, Orange Metal signs – Extreme Danger, Yellow Metal – 90-degree turn-high speed-
6. GPS & Maps Files will be **EMAILED** Monday, June 23. We will NOT be posting online. The email you used at Registration will be the email we will send them to. If you do not get the email, please email info@legacyracing.net with your race number.
7. There is no pre-running, anyone found pre-running **will** be penalized. Legacy Race Officials live in Beatty, Tonopah, Goldfield, Hawthorne, and Pahrump. You will not be able to pass through these areas without being noticed. Please respect the opportunity to race in Nevada and not jeopardize the event for everyone by pre-running.

Pit stops

1. All driver changes must be in one of our designated 25 Pit stops.
2. Please make sure your crew cleans up their pit area including all Pit signs. As much as we would like to re-use your signs, we know they are expensive.
3. Speed limits in the Pits is 25 MPH, this is for your team's protection! Please follow the Speed limit! No stop at entrance of the pit, Must be doing 25 MPH at First 25MPH Sign to avoid a penalty.
4. Pit passes are not required for this event.
5. Please make sure to follow the pit closing times, found in the front of the Chase book.
6. Please refer to our rulebook for all fueling rules & regulations. It is important to follow these guidelines!
7. Baja Pits Motorsports is offering Pit support at our three remote pits plus Tonopah Solar. To sign up please call Carlos – 619.921.8978 or Taylore – 410.804.4567 – Must sign up by June 20th!

Sportsman By Pass

1. **The following classes will be diverted after Pit 7 and head straight to Pit 11 – All Motorcycles, Quads, 3-Wheelers, Class 11, Class 1/2 1600, Class 9, Pro Stock UTV, Stock Mod UTV, Bring What You Built, 7300, 1700, 3700, Bronco, Sportsman, Group T Lite**
2. This Bypass will cross over from race mile 305 to 436 bypassing mile 306 to 435 along with Pits 8, 9 and 10.
3. Bypass is just under 2 miles long making the total distance for handlebars from Pit 7 to Pit 11 of 40 race miles. This will reduce the total race mileage to 908 miles, still the longest one-day race in the USA.

Finish Line

1. This is a high-speed finish. You do not Stop until after you go through the scoring loop.
2. You will Stop at the Stop Sign past the Scoring Loop & Trailer. It's a Large RED sign that says "STOP"
3. Please remove your helmets before you head to the podium to talk to the announcer.
4. Please stick around for post tech if required for your class (6100, 6200, Class 10, Class 5, Turbo UTV, NA UTV, Stock 1, Stock 2, Stock Mod)
5. There will be no Impound at the end of Day 1. You will be allowed to work on your race vehicles after you finish.
6. Awards will be at the Tonopah Convention Center Sunday May 14 at 9am

What to Pack: Motorcycles, Quads, 3 Wheelers

- Blinking Red Light that attaches to backpack similar to either of these: Call Butch's Speed Shop to Purchase - **(702) 247-1277** – These are Mandatory! – These are similar to ones you may have from another long-distance race.
- Reflective tape on rear om MC/Q/ 3-Wheeler
- Fueling Apron
- 5Lbs fire extinguisher in the pit for Bike, Quad & 3 Wheelers.

What to Pack: Cars, Trucks, UTVs

- Fire suits for fueling, fuel apron, balaclava, helmets recommended for fueling
- 10lb fire extinguishers for gravity fed fueling; 20lbs for pressurized

For All Classes a good reminder

- Water – You never know if you will be stranded so plan!
- Fueling Mats
- No working on race vehicle in Open toed shoes
- Race vehicle # on Chase Truck, upper windshield
- Do not go out on course, closed course and chase vehicles only in approved pit areas
- Flash lights, sunscreen, jackets for night time, plenty of fluids, watch for snakes
- First aid kit – band aids, gauze
- Work Gloves – everything will be hot to the touch!
- Trash Bags – Please clean up after yourselves!
