



This year's Dirt Rebelution will feature a different format for how the Team handlebars will be racing.

1. All handlebars will be solo riders, no teammates sharing the same machine.
2. Riders going for a Team championship will race individual machines, with a minimum of 2 entries and a maximum of 3 entries to be used for team points.
3. Rider of Record signs up as the normal race team number. 2nd and 3rd riders sign up as individual entries and use the same race number as Rider of Record with the addition of the number 2 or 3 after race number. Example:
If your race number is 1X, Rider of Record signs up as that number. Then the 2nd rider signs up with the race number 1X2 and 3rd rider signs up as 1X3.
4. Each Rider will be rewarded finishing points based on their position within their class.
5. If you are racing on a team, then points for the 2 out of the 3 Riders who finish the best on the same team will be combined giving an overall team points position for this race. For example, if Rider 1X finishes 3rd in class and Rider 1X2 finishes 8th in class, the 1X team will be rewarded 3rd and 8th place points for the weekend.
6. Points will only be rewarded to the Top 2 Riders for team points, 3rd place team rider points will be throw away points.
7. If you are going for a year end championship as a team, you must have a minimum of 2 entries with a maximum of 3 entries to increase you changes of a better overall finishing points result. Rider of Record must be one of the entries, they must race to qualify for the championship.
8. Failure to sign up multiple entries towards a team championship will make that team ineligible for a year end championship.

9. Background colors and numbers for Dirt Rebelution only:

Pro- Red background with white numbers

Expert- Black/White background with Black/White numbers or orange background with White numbers

Amateur- Yellow background with Black numbers

Novice- Green background with White numbers

10. Race numbers are assigned by Legacy in conjunction with USRA. Check registration for number associated to your class. If you don't have a number already assigned for the 2026 season that falls within that number range, please contact Legacy to have a temporary number issued.

11. if you are a team signing up and have a current 2026 number, please have 2nd and 3rd riders add the number 2 or 3 after Rider if Record number upon sign up. If you are a team and don't have a number issued for 2026, please contact Legacy prior to sign up for number.

13. Laps for each class:

Pro-2 laps

Expert- 2 laps

Amateur-2 laps

Novice- 1 lap

14. Each lap is 60 miles with 2 pit locations.

15. All Riders will be required to have a Legacy Transponder. They are \$100 to purchase or rent for the day. You can return the transponder after the race and we will refund you your \$100.

16. All riders are required to be a Legacy or USRA member. If you are already a member of either organization, you don't need to join the other one. If you are not a member, we are offering a 1 day membership for \$15 or you can pay \$70 to be a member for the remainder of the year. Note- 1 day memberships will not receive a 2026 Legacy Racer hat.

17. This is a chase race where crews can bounce back and forth between the 2 pit locations. 1 crew can cover both Main and Alternate pit as they are only about 1 mile apart with access from a paved road.
